### Mass Tidbit:

The Roman Canon continues with one of its more distinctive features: the canon (or list) of saints. Here we join our prayers with the saints in heaven. During Mass the whole Church is at prayer—not just the part here on earth, but also the saints in heaven. That's what the saints in the stained glass windows remind us of.

This part of the Roman Canon reads: “In communion with those whose memory we venerate, especially the glorious ever-Virgin Mary, Mother of our God and Lord Jesus Christ, and blessed Joseph, her spouse...” This part of the Roman Canon is thus called the *communicantes* ('in communion with'). During special times of the liturgical year there are small prefaces tied to the feast being celebrated that are added to the *communicantes*, specifically during the Octave of Christmas, on Epiphany, during the Octave of Easter, on Ascension, and on Pentecost. For example, on Easter, the prayer begins: “Celebrating the most sacred night (day) of the Resurrection of Lord Jesus Christ in the flesh, and in communion with...”

We start with the highest of the saints, Mary, and then with Joseph her spouse. We then have a list of Apostles and early popes. Some of them are little known today, so next week we'll start going through the names in the Roman Canon and looking at who they are.
